Shooting Affair

On Saturday afternoon last the country was shocked by the report of five shots in rapid succession, coming from the vicinity of the brewery of W. F. Sommercamp.

In a few minutes it was learned that there had been a shooting of five between W. H. Dewey and Joseph Koenig, in which the latter had been shot in the hip or thigh. Mr. Dewey was promptly arrested and taken into custody by the sheriff. The shooting occurred about fifteen minutes past four o'clock, and the wounded man expired about 7 P. M. It was then agreed that the examining magistrate should personally examine the positions occupied by the witnesses to the shooting, as well as that of the contending parties. The case should be committed without argument, and that the court should render its decision on Friday morning. On the evening of the shooting, the examining magistrate held the defendant without bail, to answer before the grand jury of this county at the next term of the district court.

Public Land

A statement recently issued by the Interior Department regarding the quality of public lands, and would show that, outside Alaska, there remains 300,000,000 acres, including Indian and military reservations, including Alaska, 979,000,000.

From this should be deducted the area necessary to all private land claims, 80,000,000 acres, and 7,000,000 acres for military grants, leaving about 900,000,000 acres exclusive of Alaska, surveyed and unsurveyed, for disposition. These lands are divided as follows:

Unsurveyed lands, 75,000,000 acres.
Patented lands, 10,000,000 acres.
Dakota and other recent discoveries increase the total area, which will constantly increase until all lands are surveyed.

Practically all lands containing mines, 64,000,000 acres. These will be increased by subsequent surveys. Privately owned lands remaining in the west, 3,000,000 acres, generally in isolated tracts of 10 to 20 acres. The lands in the five Southern States, surveyed, unsurveyed and reserved, 18,000,000 acres.

The irrigable lands are 20,000,000 acres of the desert land set, which may be irrigated from present water supply. Much of this, however, may be held for sale.

The unsurveyed desert lands, 440,000,000 acres. All others including pastures and reservations are estimated at over 350,000,000 acres. This estimate includes the area of military reservations, 3,000,000; the Indian reservations, estimated at 120,000,000; and 140,000,000 of which will eventually be returned to the public domain for sale. The present estimate is a vast amount of precious metals, coal, iron, copper, and other valuable minerals. Also the unsurveyed portion of Indian territory, viz., 150,000,000 acres.
