It will be needless, therefore, that missionary work be done among the boys, and I make the suggestion, gentlemen, that nickles expended in treats to the boys now will return in dollars to your tills after the appetites have formed. Above all things create the appetite." The above was given by the Anti-Saloon League by a gentleman who was present at the meeting and made exact notes at the time of what was said. The delegate who made the speech supposed none but liquor dealers were present.
