

Wrap Christmas Gifts Securely, Postal Advice

Stressing the need for every one to cooperate in the campaign, Postmaster Josephine McMurren said today, 'Early mailing of Christmas cards and gifts is the biggest single factor in getting everything delivered before Christmas.'

Naturally, the post office department plans to expand its facilities and to provide extra help during the Christmas rush, but in the final analysis, if you will follow these three simple steps, you can be certain not to disappoint friends and loved ones on Christmas day: Wrap your Christmas gifts securely, be sure they are addressed clearly and correctly, and mail all your gifts and cards early.

I hate to see folks take chances in mailing poorly wrapped packages. Despite careful wrapping, the recipient's name and address are often written over names and addresses which are incomplete or simply cannot be read.

If you have any articles of unusual size or bulk, better check with the post office before attempting to mail them. Mrs. McMurren warned that the limited size and weight of packages may depend on where you mail your Christmas gifts. As an extra precaution against loss, Postmaster McMurren advised placing both your return address and the recipient's address inside the carton package before it is wrapped.

Put a tag on each package. If you use Christmas stickers or seals, put them on the back of your Christmas cards and packages so that they will not conflict with the return address. Make sure that correct postage is firmly affixed to each card and package. When mailing gifts, it's a good idea to place a piece of transparent tape over the address portion of the label to prevent delivery men from changing the return address, to include the recipient's full return address, city, state and zip code.

Before the entire Christmas mailing period is primarily a battle against time. 'Do it now' is the slogan from the post office. Don't put off your Christmas mailings until the very last minute because this means that dreaded pile-ups will occur at the post office causing unnecessary slowdowns in delivery of the holiday greetings.

The postmaster asks the cooperation of all business firms to delay mailing Christmas cards until after December 25, to keep the mail clear for the Christmas rush.

Christmas packages for local delivery should be mailed not later than December 15, and 'be sure to mail your gifts early for nearby destinations at least a week before Christmas,' said the postmaster.
