

SMALL INSANE HOSPITAL BEST
 Washington and Other States
 In This Report.

A special New London says: (Hawaii) plan for caring for the insane of the state is said to be far superior to the systems employed by Oregon, Washington and other states.

Dr. J. W. Given, superintendent of the state institution at Oregon, and who is in fact the creator of the Idaho plan, makes several claims for it.

Dr. Given is a pioneer in the work with the insane. As early as 1853 he directed the removal of the Oregon insane asylum from Portland to Salem under Superintendent Carpenter. He has given his life to the study of improving the conditions of the unfortunate, and has solved the major problem by the creation of the small institution for the insane.

Working One-Block Plan
 Dr. Given was superintendent of the Idaho state asylum at Blackfoot. The legislature provided for the establishment of a small Idaho institution.

Following the selection of the site at Blackfoot, 48 men from the Blackfoot institution were sent to Dr. Given and summer camps were established on the newly acquired ground. During the summer, the brick building, the ground cleared and the first winter set in the main building of the Oregon institution was completed. The small institution was opened to the number of about 100 were taken there.

Further additions have been made and the present building with its grounds are largely the product of the efforts of the patients. The building operations have been continued since the report of Superintendent Given, the cost of operation is proportionately less than the large institutions.

Expense Is Light.
 There are 215 patients at Oregon, and the plan provide for a maximum of 250. Added from Superintendent Given, the highest salaries are \$500 per month, while the average is \$32 per month. The farm produce all vegetables, daily necessities and meat for the institution are raised on the premises.

Dr. Given is advocating the establishment of a second institution in the extreme north of the state, where ideal home conditions for the patients and a permanent study of each case and the advantages of recreation in the open air could demonstrate the superiority of the small institution over the larger percentage of permanent care offered.

Dr. Given is in Oregon at present. He is visiting the state and will visit the small institution plan. The report of Governor West in the House of Representatives would provide all labor necessary in the establishment of the small state institution.
