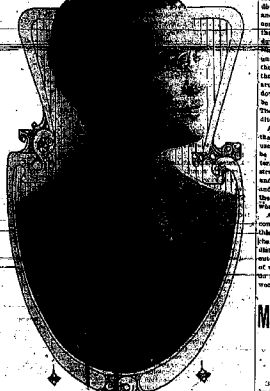
SENATOR PENNELL HAS INTRODUCED A BILL TO REPEAL THE VETO POWER OF THE GOVERNOR.
