



BILL VALUES IDIOM WHEAT

Interesting Bulletin from Experiment Station Covering Past Three Years.

MOOREHEAD, May 12.—The Bulletin of Idaho wheat experiments, a recently published bulletin of the Idaho agricultural experiment station. The investigation covered a period of three years and involved scientific methods, laboratory and home testing.

The conclusion is reached that the leading varieties grown in Idaho are: Bluebird, 2-ary-3-4, Little Chief, and Chief. Chief and Turkey Red, in the North; Bluebird, Colorado No. 55, Duquesne, Jackson, field corn and Turkey Red, in the south at their best.

The wheat of north Idaho and the introduced wheat of south Idaho are of practically the same value for milling purposes. South Idaho dry farm wheat is superior to others. To improve the value of the crop, the university experts urge the growing of only the best varieties and the introduction of a system of crop rotation. Grain of high gluten content should be produced without adequate nitrogen in the soil. Large quantities of Idaho wheat are grown on land made fertile by deficient nitrogen or which has been exhausted by the growing of wheat and other small grains year after year.
