Out in the Open At Last!

The patriotic gentlemen who are endeavoring to curtail Washington County with the liquor saloon have at last published their Confession of Faith. The first article declares that it is impossible to have saloons in Weiser; for saloon licenses are to be granted only to "men of good moral character and habits!"

It is the general opinion of all good people that no "man of good moral character and habits" will disgrace himself and his family by conducting a crooked-making factory. Therefore the church will not receive a saloon keeper into membership; neither will the Masons, Odd Fellows, Foresters, Knights of Pythias, and many other highly respectable Brotherhoods.

Secondly, they propose to "regulate" the number of saloons. Indeed! Mark, they do not say "guarantee" that the number will be limited. But why limit the number? If the saloon is a good thing for the town why not have one on every corner? One saloon even may be worse than a dozen.

Please pause just here, gentle reader, and notice an innocent little joker, a colored gentleman in the fact here—also to speak! By the terms of this Article of Faith in connection with Article Six, it will appear that only the "betels" can sell liquor! This is very patriotic and self-denying merely on the part of a disinterested (?) few who have benevolently acquired gentry blocks of Hotel Stock!

The third Article is intensely interesting; for it proposes to have every saloon conducted in a "quiet and orderly manner!" The No License Committee will cheerfully give to these gentlemen a reward of \$100 for the discovery of a town on this Continent where every saloon is conducted in a "quiet and orderly manner!" The gaining of this reward will in a small way add to the completion fund sent to Weiser by the Boise Board!

It will be instructive to the voters of this county to read how well the "business men" of Boise have kept a similar pledge!

The fourth Article is also attractive; for it

proposes to prohibit the "sale of liquor to minors, or persons in an intoxicated condition." This has always been the law in Weiser, and here again we will give a reward of \$100 for proof that there ever existed in Weiser a saloon that obeyed that law! The fifth Article of Faith seems to be unspokeably cruel even for license advocates! The poor patron of the new fangled saloon—no matter how tired he may be, can have no chair to sit on, no table to hold his "shooner's" and no friendly "cuffin" to screen the weary limber from the gaze of the public among which may be his wife! How consistent are our license friends! With one breath they exclaim: "The saloon is the poor man's club," and then they declare that the poor man must stand and take it no matter how tired he may be! Again we will pay a liberal reward for the discovery of such a model saloon anywhere.

The sixth Article certainly proves that these saloon regulators have very little of the "milk of human kindness" in their patriotic bosoms! They discover this new specimen of genius known as a saloon keeper with "good moral character and habits," put him in this mold, chairless, tableless, curtainless, open-to-the-public-view place; to bless our town with a "regulated" saloon, and then—near it Oh ye hills of Hamilton and wares of Oxnard!—for this inestimable service they would—tax—the poor man—\$100 per month in advance, etc., etc., in addition to the present State and County license! Surely the poor man must be supported by the County—at the County poor farm!

The seventh Article of Faith drives the thorn still more deeply into the victim's brow; for if started into a "violation of these requirements" he "forfeits his license money" and is summarily kicked out of his model saloon! Surely the "best state of Utah" is worse than the first!

The eighth and last article would decrease the work of this "mercenary, mold," regulated "drinking place," with some temporary ordinance by some inamiable City Council of a "tax pay-

ing league" run city of Weiser! Isn't all this flimsy dust for your eyes, Mr. Voter?

The authors of this supernatural Confession of Faith are rinit with apny because the city council, the county sheriff, the district attorney, and county court at comband are unable to enforce the law against a few encouraged "boot-leggers," and yet they dream of a saloon keeping millitium in which all the provisions of their anrtle Confession will be easily enforced! Of course not; but these patriots pay taxes in Washington County! Of course not!

In a "free" election these gentlemen give the names of "A partial list" of the firms that belong to the celebrated "tax payer league," and they wish the innocent, unsophisticated voters to believe that every person connected with all those firms will vote "yes" next Wednesday; whereas such is far from the fact.

Be not deceived, gentle voter, by any such trash and nonsense. Every one of the men endeavoring to reestablish saloons in this county knows that the saloon is a curse to any town. He knows that the imaginary saloon described in this amazing Confession of Faith is an absolute impossibility as a practical fact, but because he hopes to make some money out of the infant business, directly or indirectly, or desires a "regulated" public place where he can get his own "eye openers" and "night caps," he is willing to reestablish the pestiferous thing known as a saloon in this County! We mentioned to these misguided and misguiding men the wise opinion of the martyred McKinley: "The liquor traffic is the most degrading and ruinous of all human pursuits. By legalizing this traffic we agree to share with the liquor seller the responsibilities and evils of the business. Every man who votes for license becomes a partner of the liquor traffic and all the consequences."
