Parcels Weighing up to Eleven Pounds Can Be Sent by Mail After January 1, 1913—Rate Given.

In response to many inquiries for information regarding the proposed change in the postal law, the postmaster general has issued the following information:

Under the present law, parcels weighing up to five pounds may be sent by mail. After January 1, 1913, the weight limit will be increased to eleven pounds.

The rate for parcels weighing up to five pounds will remain the same. The rate for parcels weighing between five and eleven pounds will be 10 cents per pound.

Weight	Rate
Up to 5 lbs.	50 cents
5 to 11 lbs.	10 cents per pound

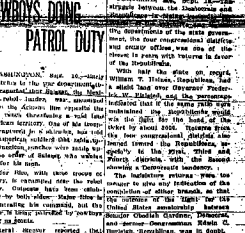
