Home Gleaned From Files of The Signal

75 YEARS AGO
Sept. 27, 1900

In 1900 folks didn't need to have movie to tell them stories of rustlers for they lived the life depicted in the movies. Of course there weren't any movies in 1900, but maybe this incident was used in a later movie.

While out combing the hills near Sand Hollow for stock, Bird Lynch and Coode Wilson noticed a bunch of horses at the head of the draw known as Wet Gulch, so they rode over to see if any of them belonged to them.
