For the tiny tots, *While the Candles Burn: Eight Stories for Hanukkah* by Irene Smalls and illustrated by Melody Rosales is the story of a young girl making the most of Christmas while living in the southern slave quarters of the 1800s.  
As for more traditional children's Christmas stories, *Frosty the Snowman* retold by Annie North Bedford and illustrated by Jean Chandler, and *Grandpa's Long Red Underwear* by Lynn Shettle and illustrated by Emily A. McCully are good choices.

The library also has several books about cooking and decorating that are perfect for assisting the host (or hostess) with the most (or mostest). *The Pillsbury Party Book* is sure to contain recipes for your favorite goody, high-calorie treats. *Holiday Magic* by Margaret Perry and *Better Homes and Gardens' Holiday Decorations You Can Make* both contain lots of ideas to help you beautify your home. As for dinner music, *A Treasury of Christmas Songs and Carols* edited by Henry W. Simon contains all of your favorite holiday tunes.

### Student exchange program signing-up host families

International high school exchange students will arrive soon for spring semester homestays and the Share! Exchange Program still needs a few more local families to host them.  
The exchange students, all between 15 and 18 years of age, are interested in learning more about the United States and American culture. They live with volunteer American families while attending local high schools for a semester or an academic year.  
To insure they are good students and English-speaking, the students are

screened and oriented before acceptance into the Share! Program. They also carry accident and medical insurance and bring personal spending money, according to Roger Riske, president of Educational Resource Development Trust, the non-profit foundation that sponsors the Share! Program.  
The ERDT/Share! program coordinator for Weiser and surrounding communities will help families select a student with similar interests and will provide information about the program during an informal in-home meeting. Host families for ERDT/Share! are eligible for a \$50 per month charitable contribution tax deduction during the hosting period.  
Weiser area families interested in learning more about student exchange or meeting with the area's Share! program coordinator should call the ERDT/Share! national office at 1-800-321-3738. ERDT/Share! urges that interested people call soon, preferably by Dec. 31.
